

PY16 RFP Questions & Answers

Q: Is profit allowed?

A: NCWWDB is not structured for its contracted providers to profit from the WIOA TI programs. The funds for this Request for Proposal (RFP) are made available through the Federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Title 1 on a cost reimbursement basis.

Q: Who are the current providers of these services?

A: Forward Service Corporation currently holds the contract for the Youth and Adult Programs in all nine counties of the workforce development area. Labor, Education & Training Center (LETC) currently holds the Dislocated Worker contract in all nine counties.

Q: Is there performance data available for the last complete program year?
